Banner for Students

What is Banner?

Banner is the student information system used by Loyalist College.

How Do I Access Banner?

Go to www.myloyalist.com and select 'Banner'.



Enter the 'secure area'.



User ID and PIN

Your User ID is your Loyalist student ID (not your OCAS ID). Your pin is your birth date in the format of YYMMDD. For example, if your birthday is October 20, 1985 your pin would be 851020.

The first time you access Banner you will be prompted to change your pin and enter a security question. Your pin must be six digits.

- 4) Gross summer earnings
- 5) Void cheque or direct deposit slip from your bank
