Position Summary:

Reporting to the Dean/Chair, School of Business, Bio-Sciences, and Justice Studies a part time faculty will facilitate the delivery of a course or courses in Culinary Management / Chef Training. Courses include: Culinary Techniques-Basic and Cuisine A la Carte. The courses are delivered on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesdays from April to June 24th. The position is for a minimum of 6 hours (1 day) up to a maximum 12 hours (2 days).

Specific duties and responsibilities:
