

Since 1967, Loyalist College has grown with its community/region in Eastern Ontario. Today, the College has two campuses – Belleville and Bancroft – and an annual budget of \$60M. Loyalist is THE public post-secondary portal serving a population of 250,000 in this region of Ontario.


