


STUDYING AT LOYALIST

HEALTH INSURANCE

Your tuition payment includes mandatory one-year health insurance for international students while you are in Canada. It is highly recommended that you purchase your own travel insurance if arriving in Canada before this date. Students who do not confirm with the International Coordinator that they are planning to arrive and begin classes will not be automatically registered for this insurance and therefore will not be covered. Medical attention can be expensive in Canada, so it is very important to have this coverage. Your policy will not cover pre-existing conditions.

IMMUNIZATION RECORD

Some programs, as part of the admission requirements, and to meet legislation for placement in various community facilities, require submission of the Loyalist College Immunization Record. This must be completed and returned directly to the Loyalist Health Centre. It is advisable for all international students to bring proof of immunization and medical records to Canada regardless of whether it is required for your program.

CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION CANADA (CIC)

International students coming to study in Canada are required to apply for a Study Permit and, if applicable, a Temporary Residence Visa (TRV or Entry Visa). Please visit the CIC website at cic.gc.ca for more information and to understand the rules and regulations on becoming an international student studying in Canada.

WORKING IN CANADA

As outlined by Canada Immigration, international students must be full-time students and in good academic standing to be eligible to work off campus. Jobs are not guaranteed for international students. Students will need to apply with a résumé and possibly have a job interview before being hired. Our Career Services office will be available to provide guidance to international students applying for jobs on our campus and in our community.

We have five suite-style buildings with space for 476 students. We also have 104 spots for upper-year students in four fully-furnished townhouse buildings.



HERE'S WHAT YOU'LL FIND IN OUR ON-CAMPUS SUITE-STYLE RESIDENCES:

- Each suite has six individual bedrooms, two bathrooms, a kitchen and a common living area
- Students have their own private, carpeted bedroom with a window, furnished with a bed, desk, bookshelf, dresser, corkboard and night table
- Kitchen and dining areas are equipped with a fridge, stove, microwave, dishwasher, dining table, chairs, loveseat, and a coffee table
- Barrier-free units are available in three buildings
- Residences are equipped with laundry facilities, sports pad with basketball hoops, beach volleyball court, bicycle sheds, picnic tables, a sheltered outdoor patio and outdoor barbecues
- A centrally located Residence Centre has a computer lab, a coffee shop, a lounge area with a limestone fireplace, and a sunken living room with a big-screen TV

OFF-CAMPUS HOUSING

New arriving students are provided with free accommodation for up to five nights while they look for housing that suits their budget and preferences. The Student Leader program will provide assistance in navigating the community to secure suitable housing.

TRANSPORTATION

Belleville Transit (BT) runs a dedicated Loyalist route connecting the College with the City and the Quinte Mall. Weekday buses run every half-hour between 6:30 am and 7 pm and hourly between 7 and 10 pm. Weekend schedules and maps are available from BT.

Our newly-equipped Biosciences labs and skilled trades workshops are part of our 121,800-square-foot LEED® Silver certified The Bay of Quinte Skills Centre. The Centre also includes the Link Lounge, which features quiet glass-enclosed study pods, a laptop counter, a sunken lounge and a vertical garden stretching across one of its walls! The 25-foot self-sufficient living wall features more than 300 plants that create a bio-filter system to improve the Lounge's air quality.


COMMUNITY LIFE

THE BAY OF QUINTE REGION

Loyalist College sits on the border between Belleville and Quinte West, just north of Prince Edward County. These scenic waterfront regions are tucked in among agricultural producers and some of the province's hottest tourist destinations. The result is a unique place that combines the convenience of big-city living with small-town warmth. DINE OUT

There are lots of options for dining out, ranging from quick and convenient to gourmet and international cuisine for every taste, including Thai, Italian, Greek, French, Vietnamese, Chinese, Indian, Himalayan, Korean and Japanese. And of course there's always pizza delivery! The community offers Halal and various vegetarian options.

The region also boasts an abundance of farm-to-table options with fresh produce and home preserves at open-air farmers' markets in **Belleville's Market Square** and on the Trent River waterfront, as well as at roadside stands dotting the landscape in Prince Edward County.

EXPLORE THE OUTDOORS

There's plenty to do in every season, whether you like extreme watersports, snowboarding or just strolling on the Waterfront Trail. Across the Bay of Quinte you'll find **Sandbanks Provincial Park**, the world's largest freshwater sand bar and dune system and one of the most beautiful beaches in Ontario. Come to swim, sunbathe, windsurf, wakeboard, waterski, sail, canoe or kayak. Winter is full of frosty activities with snowmobiling trails, tobogganing, outdoor skating and ice fishing on the Bay of Quinte. For those who like downhill sports, Loyalist is just 20 minutes from the **Batawa Ski Hill**.

There are also indoor opportunities year-round at the newly expanded **Quinte Sports & Wellness Centre**, with four rinks, three pools, an indoor track and hundreds of fitness and recreational programs.

ENJOY CULTURE

There are many artists' studios and galleries to visit, and a **Studio Tour** each fall. You'll also find a lively performing arts scene with professional and community theatre, as well as indoor and outdoor concert venues.

HOW TO APPLY

International students may apply directly to the College. Please visit loyalistcollege.com for detailed admission requirements.

International Student Fees*

Visa student applicants must pay the following fees for regular full-time post-secondary programs (two semesters per year). Fees for programs that are less than or greater than two semesters will be adjusted. A minimum payment of one semester is required prior to the commencement of classes. Students are encouraged to pay the entire academic year in one transfer. Textbooks, instruments and supplies vary in cost and will be added on to the invoice.

Language Requirements

All instruction within the College is in English. In order to be successful in a program, communication, listening comprehension, reading and writing skills must be at a level sufficient to meet the demands of post-secondary studies. All applicants to Loyalist whose first language is not English, or whose previous education has been conducted in another language, will be expected to provide an English proficiency assessment.

Transfer Credits

Applicants with training from other institutions should submit documentation to Loyalist at the time of application. Transfer credits from other post-secondary institutions will be assessed on an individual basis.


Scholarships

As part of immigration requirements, international students are required to prove that they have sufficient funds to fully support themselves during their stay in Canada. Funding for international students is limited, but each year Loyalist College awards a number of smaller scholarships to international students through the International Centre. Students will be provided with the information to apply for scholarships when available. You may also qualify for international scholarships available at scholarships.gc.ca.
