ABOUT THE W. GARFIELD WESTON FOUNDATION

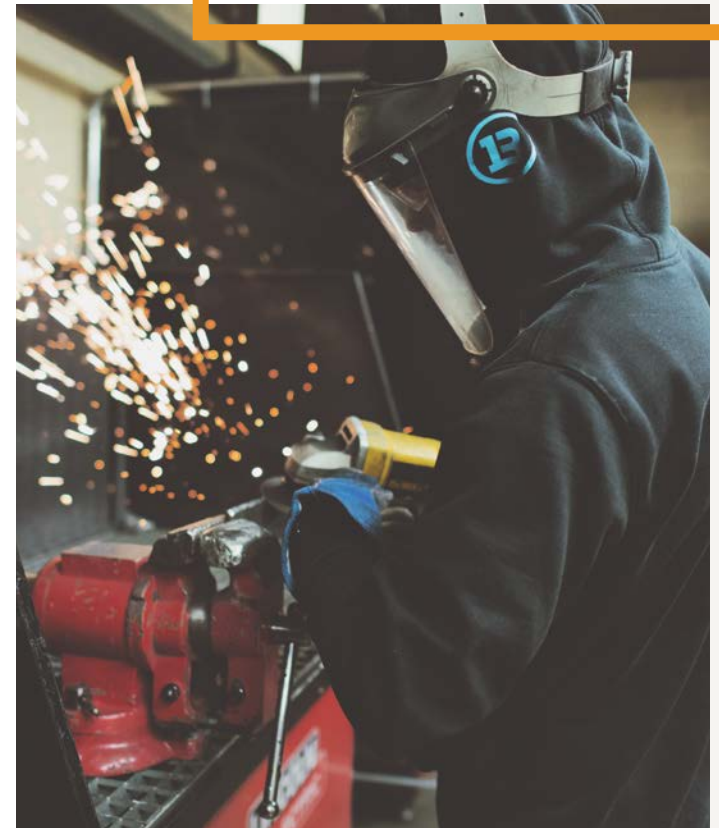

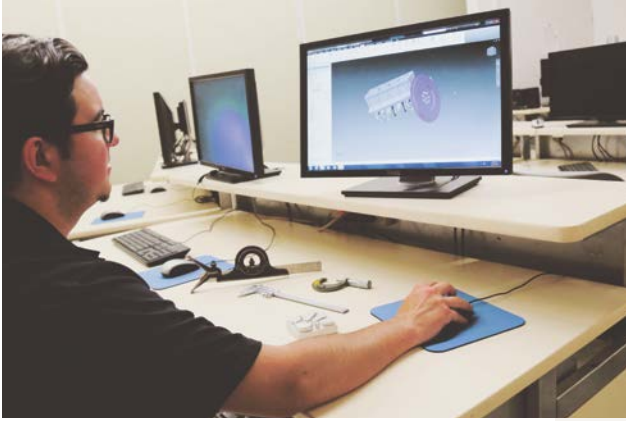

WHAT IS THE DEADLINE TO APPLY FOR 2018?

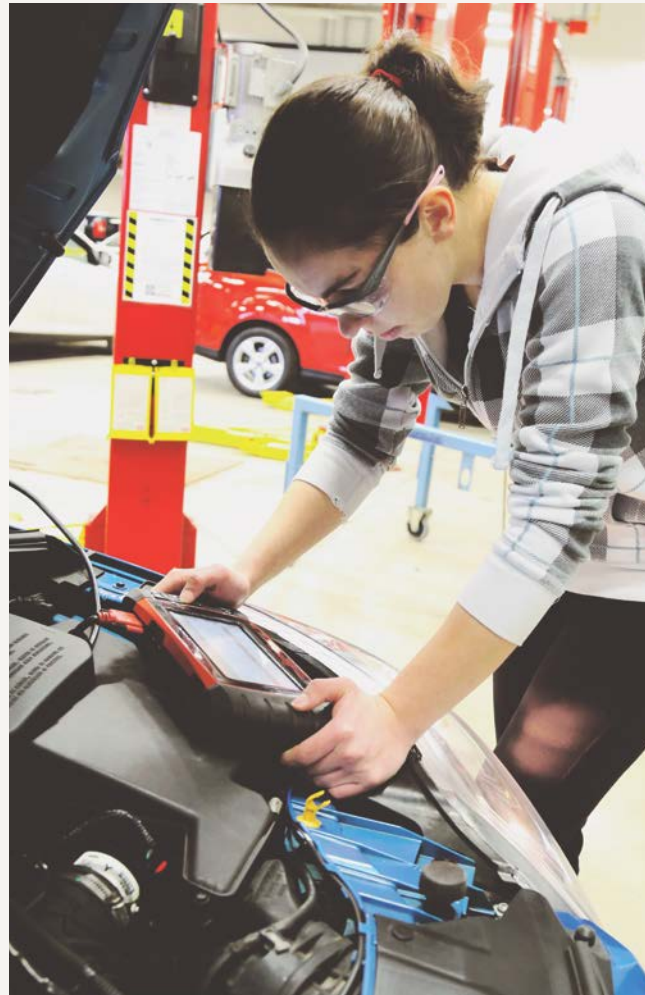

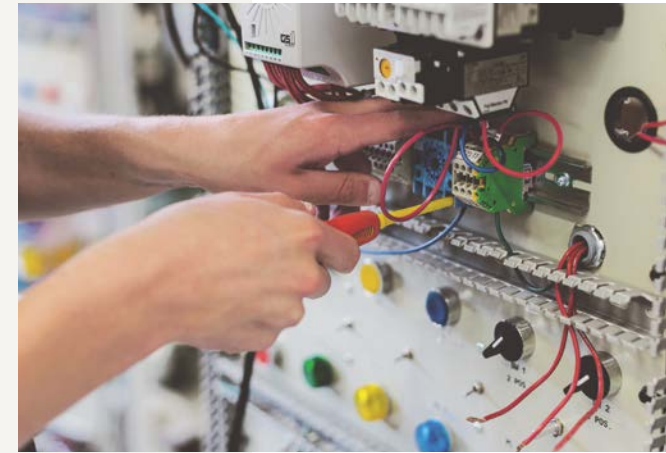
SELECTION CRITERIA:
