Efforts will be made to contact students before 7:00 a.m. on event day if the weather causes a postponement. Please monitor local radio stations for announcements.
2. Secondary schools will register student competitors with their Board's Skills Competition Co-ordinator.
3. Signed *Registration and Permission to Participate* form **and** *Media Consent/Release* form must be submitted before a student can be registered as a participant. **Space is limited and filled on a first come first served basis.**
4. Loyalist College and the East Central Ontario Training Board will be working with area school boards to register student participants for the Skills competition. No information will be maintained or used by either organization following the competition.
5. Competitors must review the 'scopes' and other information for their competition to ensure they have an understanding of the general expectations for the day as well as the skills and knowledge that they may be asked to demonstrate at the competition.
Note: Scopes will identify if there are hand tools/equipment and personal safety equipment that they must provide for themselves at the event.
6. Competitors must wear the safety equipment/clothing identified for the competition in which they are competing.
