### **Review of Minutes:**

Minutes from the Indigenous Circle meeting of February 22, 2019 were reviewed.

**PEFAL Funding Year End Report:** Final report for the 2018-2019 academic year was originally scheduled to be submitted on May 30, 2019 but was extended to June 30, 2019.

**Land Acknowledgement:** Final approval was given for the land acknowledgement as follows: "Loyalist College is located on the territory of the Huron-Wendat, the Anishnaabeg, and the Haudenosaunee people. We acknowledge our shared obligation to respect, honour, and sustain these lands and the natural resources contained within."

**Designated Seats:** Discussion was held in regards to having designated seats for Indigenous students in over-subscribed programs. Vice-President Academic agreed that this should move forward, with consultation with the Registrar.

**CiCAN Conference:** Manager, Indigenous Services, Vice-President Academic, and Vice-President, External Relations attended the CiCAN Conference in Niagara Falls May 5-7, 2019.

**Wampum Recreation:** The Two Row Wampum belt will be completed and ready to present at Orientation this year. To date, 33 faculty, 41 staff, 19 students, 20 administrators, and 8 community members have participated in the re-creation of the belt.

**Indoor and Outdoor Spaces:** Work on the new Indigenous Resource Centre is due to be completed shortly with plan to move back into the space prior to Convocation. Work on the outdoor learning circle is set to be completed by late spring.

### **Other Business:**

- ***MBQ Candidate for Board of Governors*** – The current Board of Governors' Indigenous representative's time is up this spring. It is necessary to decide on another member of MBQ to approach for a position on the Board.
